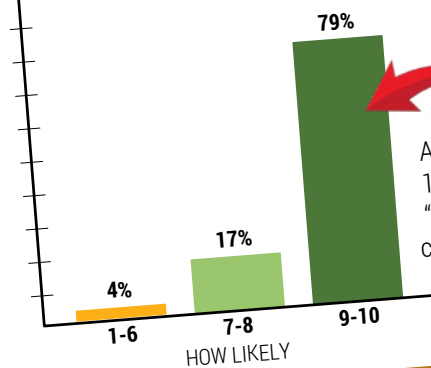

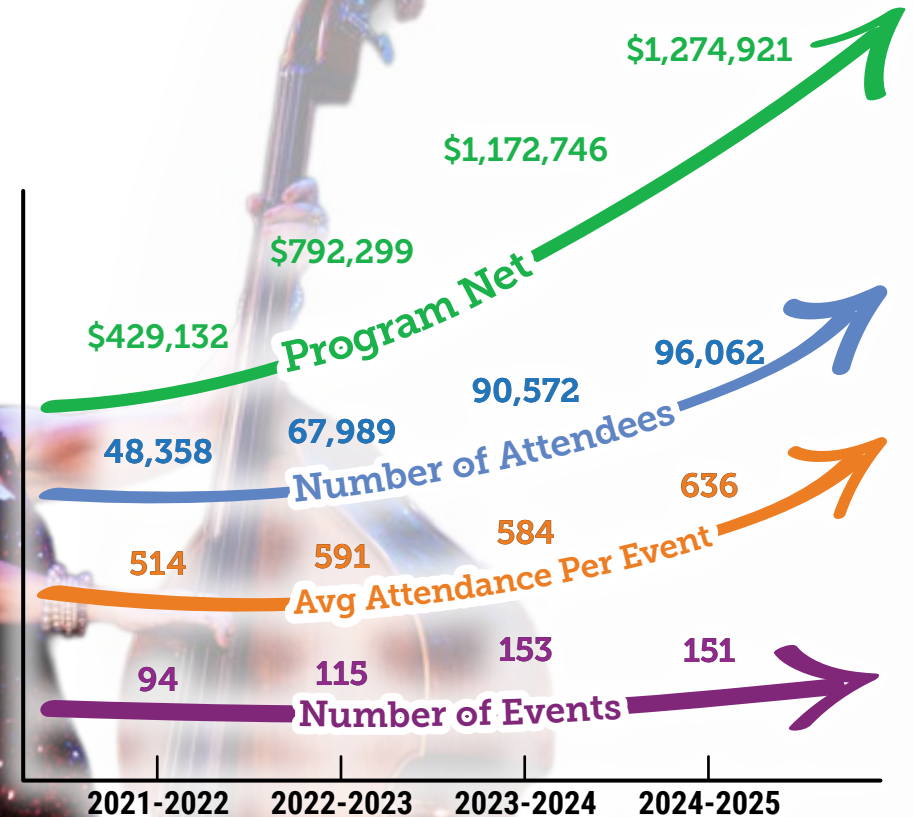

The financial picture at the Fox just keeps improving, thanks to our beautiful venue, strategic selection of amazing artists, excellent management, and most importantly **YOU** - our loyal fans!

Since reopening in 21/22 after the prolonged pandemic shutdown, the Fox has experienced extraordinary and sustained year over year growth, with total attendance during this time period up 99%, average attendance per event up 24%, and direct net from core program activities up 197%.



# Inspiring the Next Generation

The KITT Program served **14,978** youth & adults, doubled its staff, and introduced multiple new programs, including free storytime, sensory-friendly programs, and a two-week summer day camp.



**71** workshops serving 2,112 students & educators



**3,610** complimentary tickets given to teachers, Title I schools, youth & their caregivers via partner non-profits, plus free events such as storytime & Monsoon Literacy Celebration.

The Kids In The Theatre (KITT) program – with its special mascot KITT the Fox – offers a variety of programming: school matinees, storytime, autism-friendly events, family shows, educator training, and summer day camps, often in partnership with individual schools, entire districts, and other youth-serving nonprofits.

Arts experiences help kids grow in creativity, confidence, curiosity, and problem-solving. They also support mental and physical well-being. Studies show that the arts can improve child development, critical thinking, reduce stress, strengthen social connections, and even boost the immune system. Kids who participate in arts programs are more likely to stay engaged in school and community life—and are less likely to face mental health challenges later in life.

We continue to make exciting progress on the big, bold plans for an expanded Fox Tucson Theatre around the corner at Stone & Congress. The project is on track to break ground on an expanded facility in 2028 with a projected opening of the Performing Arts Center in 2030, the 100th anniversary of the Fox. Over the course of this past year, the project team focused on gathering input from hundreds of diverse users and stakeholders, and that process has led to a still evolving design. The image above represents a step in the design development process as of June 2025.

Because the Fox is a beloved community asset, we are deeply committed and excited to shape an expansion that we can all be proud of, one that fits current needs while honoring the stories and the aesthetic beauty of our history. In tandem with the historic Fox, this performing arts center will stand as a highly visible showplace, a defining feature of Tucson, and a hub of artistic excellence, community, and joy.

Thanks to early commitments from major funders and donors – including \$2 million from Rio Nuevo, \$1.6 million from the Bert W. Martin Foundation, a combined \$1.6 million from Fox Tucson Theatre Foundation Board members, and \$1.3 million from other generous supporters – we have raised \$6.5 million (25% of the overall campaign goal) to date.

This project isn't just about more space – it's about ensuring that the Fox remains a leader in Tucson's cultural and economic future. With it, we ensure that the Fox thrives not just as a historic gem, but as a future-ready, resilient, vibrant performing arts hub.

## The expansion will:

- Add a second flexible theatre space seating up to 300
- Increase accessible restrooms and ADA-compliant features, including elevators
- Provide flexible spaces for performance and community events
- Integrate modern technology and revenue-generating amenities
- Preserve and uplift the historic theatre for generations to come

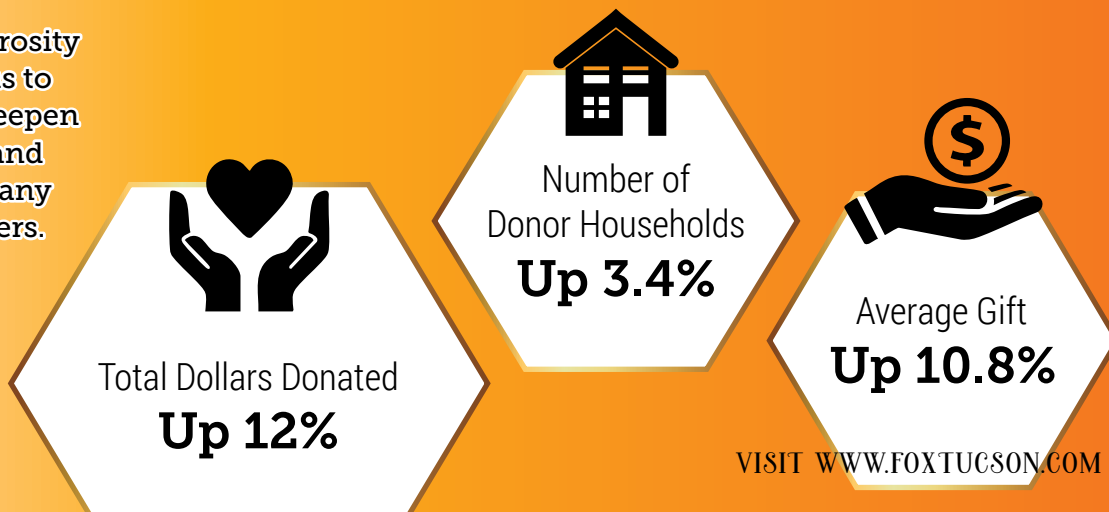

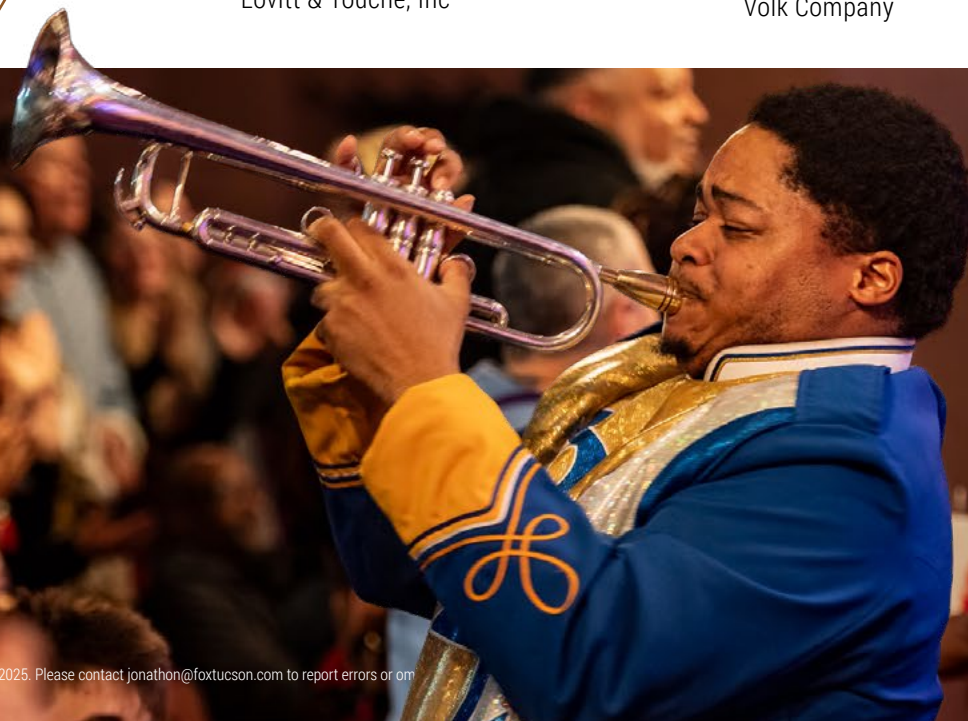
